



EMW Student Poster Session rules

- I. The conference will offer the Best Poster Awards to the three best posters.
- II. Contestants are obliged to send an abstract prior to the 1th of March 2019.
- III. Abstract should be 290- 350 words in length.
- IV. Max score is 100 points.
- V. Judges can ask questions only according to the poster topic and the content.
- VI. Point scale is as following:

Content Correctness (0 – 30): The poster topic and content is correct in the knowledge matter.

Poster Appearance (0 – 15): The poster is printed correctly. The graphs are good to read. Presentation is clear. Grade is higher when the poster is more attractive for the viewers.

Innovativeness (0 – 25): The poster shows that there are reliable proofs of innovativeness technology or technique.

Laboratory Research (0 – 5): Posters which are proof of laboratory research are granted with extra points as they are the most time absorbing.

Correct Answers (0 – 25): Authors are confident in their answers and are answering correctly.

A poster presented on a poster session during East meets West International Student Petroleum Congress and Career Expo should be of a size of **A0 (1189 mm x 841 mm)**, preferably in vertical orientation.

Poster evaluation criteria:

Properly prepared poster should have a title and listed authors, introduction, methods (clear outline of procedures) and conclusions/future directions. The evaluation of technical side relates to the poster's legibility (adequate font size, quality of printing, etc.), materials used and overall visual appeal (layout of text and figures).

The author should be able to present a scientific merit of a poster (approximately 5-minute presentation in front of jury) and understand the materials. Involvement in interesting the audience and answering to the possible questions is an additional advantage.

All the posters have to be delivered 9th of April (the first day of EMW Congress) to the Reception Desk in U2 building.
